DUE DILIGENCE ON CONFLICT MINERALS

Itacoil is committed to ensuring that the minerals used in its products do not come from sources involved in armed conflicts, in compliance with the OECD Due Diligence Guidance for Responsible Supply Chains of Minerals from Conflict-Affected and High-Risk Areas and the requirements of the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act - Section 1502.

Procurement Policy

- We require our raw material and finished product suppliers to complete the Conflict Minerals Reporting Template (CMRT), updated every three years or in case of supply chain changes.
- We only accept supplies from smelters that have passed an independent audit and are certified by the Responsible Minerals Initiative (RMI) through the Responsible Minerals Assurance Process
- If a smelter indicated by our suppliers is not listed by the RMI, we request the use of a compliant smelter.

Due Diligence Process

- Our suppliers must ensure supply chain traceability by providing references to raw material manufacturers along with technical and safety specifications.
- During general audits, we verify that stock materials come from the suppliers declared in the CMRT.
- If inconsistencies arise, we require their resolution within an agreed timeframe. In case of noncompliance, we terminate the business relationship.
